More Camp Stuff you need to know! Camp Edisto 2011 is approaching... and We are hoping to see you this summer but before you come please read all of the information contained in this letter so that you, your children, and your church family will be thoroughly prepared for Camp. @475 Campers and staff showed up last summer...let's top it this summer! Invite your friends!...put the colored dot somewhere as a prayer reminder...on your mirror...cell ph...computer screen...just do it and pray like crazy...and God will be honored and Camp blessed!

Registration Guidelines: All campers must attend their age / correct week of camp. The age of the camper at the beginning of the coming school year is the guideline used for registration purposes. **First Chance Campers should be accompanied (for free) by an adult or older sibling (12 yrs. or older)**

- There is a limit of campers per week. Registration is first-come, first served
- **Deadlines for registration:**
- **May 5th Early-Bird** Sr. & Jr. Hi / Inter. \$100 (\$20 –1st Chance / \$70 Junior)
 - **After May 5th** – Sr. & Jr. Hi / Inter. \$125 (\$30 – 1st Chance / \$90 Junior)
 - **All registrations** must be received by Larry Bradberry at least one week before the start of specified camp. Walk-up registrations discouraged.
 - If the week is full, you will be notified and registration fees returned.
 - If you are unable to pay the full registration amount by the deadline, and/or need further financial assistance, please contact your home church or any of the camp directors listed at the end of this letter.
- **Check-In begins at 4 p.m. on Sunday**, and will take place in the dining hall. *****Campers are not allowed on campus until 3:30 p.m.*****
- **Sr., Jr. & Intermediate Camp ends on Friday at 10 a.m.** (prompt pick-up)
- **Jr. week ends & pick up is 5:30 p.m. Wed. / no dinner served**
- **First chance** arrive at 4 p.m. Friday – **depart** Saturday after lunch @ 1 p.m.
- Campers must be **checked-out** for any reason by the dean or appointed person
- **All medications** will be left with the camp nurse or camp dean at Check-In. Campers will see camp nurse to receive daily meds.

General Policy Guidelines

- **Campers are not permitted to use cell phones.** (If a cell phone is seen it will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp week). These items of convenience can quickly become distractions at camp. There is a phone at the camp for *****emergencies only please (803-274-8574)*****
- Campers are not to bring their own food and drinks. Each week of camp offers ample opportunity for meals and snacks. Extra food and drinks in the cabins only invite unwanted visitors (ants, roaches, etc.) and opportunities to steal.
- Cars are only permitted in the designated areas for drop-off. Please do not drive past the Dining Hall and park among the trees. This creates a safety hazard for the campers. After drop-off on Sunday, cars must stay parked in the parking area in front of the Chapel.
- All visitors must first check-in with the camp dean. If they are staying for a meal there will be a charge of \$5, if extra food is available. Visitors are generally discouraged because of the possible interruption of the camp program.

What you can do to prepare your camper: Start Praying now!

***What to Bring:* Bible, pen, toiletries, bedding / pillow for twin bed, swimwear (no two-pieces), money for missions offering & canteen, bug spray, & ball glove.**

***Optional:* (fan & thermal water cup for cabin use)**

- ***Review the registration sheet*** – make sure all information is added and current.
- ***Everyone Pray often for Camp Edisto 2011***...it's an awesome investment for all!
- Do not suggest to your child that he/she can call home if he/she gets homesick. If the camper desires to make a decision for Christ to be baptized or is not engaging in the camp program due to illness, homesickness or discipline issues, parents and or guardians who signed registration form will be contacted. Please remind your child that this is a Christian camp ministry and no fighting, bullying, use of bad language, or disruptive behavior will be tolerated. Remind them of these rules before coming to camp!
